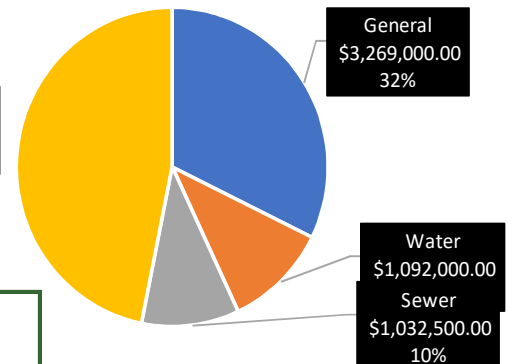
Hello Florida,

We take managing your tax dollars very seriously and with the help of the graphs, show you where your dollars go. We have several capital improvement projects in the works this year which includes completion of our Water plant revitalization, parking lot expansion along the senior center, and sewer plant upgrades to name a few. Many of these projects are in conjunction with state grants (including \$3 million for the water plant) which is your taxes being reinvested into the community!
